As is often the case, even though Kevin and Daniel went to encourage the people of Kambantsa, they themselves left encouraged as well. We hope to have more visits like this in the near future to other villages, in coordination with one of the missionaries we regularly serve. Pray for the people of Kambantsa, that they will remain strong in their faith and reach out to their neighboring communities. Mission work in the jungles of Ecuador is somewhat slow, and progress can be hard to see at times, but we know that our work is not in vain and that God's Word will not return empty (Isaiah 55:11).
